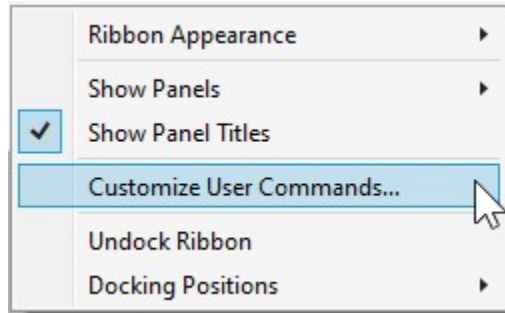


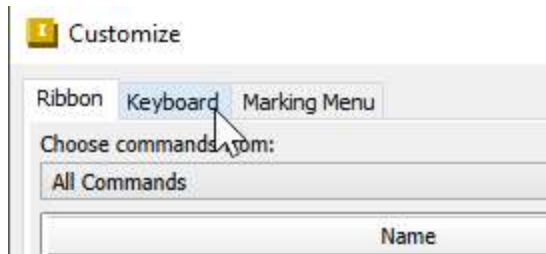
Property Editor Toggle Command

Prior to starting, ensure you have Installed the iPropWiz 7.xx.1.243 or later build.

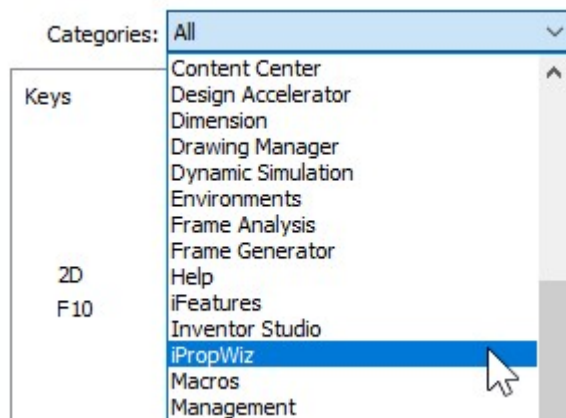
1. Right-click in the Inventor ribbon and click Customize User Commands.



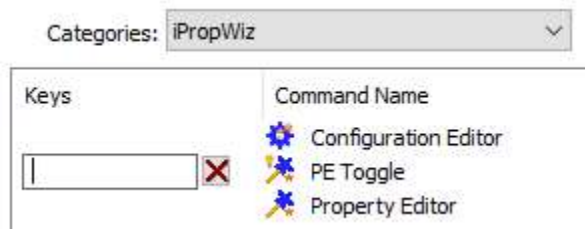
2. In the Customize dialog, click the Keyboard tab.



3. Select iPropWiz from the Categories drop-down list.



4. Click the Keys column to the left of the PE Toggle command.



5. Press and hold any combination of the Ctrl, Alt, and Shift keys and then press an alphanumeric character [A-Z, 0-9] to define the shortcut. The shortcut is displayed in the Keys column.



6. Click OK or click Apply and then lose the Customize dialog.
7. Open a document and then open the iPropWiz Property Editor (PE).
8. Test the shortcut while Inventor has the focus, and when you are working in the PE. Use the shortcut again to re-enable the PE.

Note: The shortcut performs the same action as clicking the Active button at the end of the PE toolbar.
